The Hay Creek Township Board will be holding the annual meeting for township residents on **Tuesday, March 20, 2018 at 6pm at the Holy Cross Lutheran Church, 7111 Williamson Dr. (on Hwy 1804 just west of Hwy 83 and east of North Washington St.). Please bring a copy of this newsletter and valid picture ID to get a ballot to vote.**

The agenda for the meeting includes:

- A discussion of timely notification efforts started by the township board to notify township residents of possible changes in zoning, etc. that the City of Bismarck has received a request for and will be considering for approval,
- The budget and mill levy for the township,
- Brief presentations on board members' duties, time demands and term ending dates,
- The appointment of one Board Supervisor,
- Information regarding the Hwy 83 alternative study that could impact Hay Creek township residents (those living within the study area-east of Hwy 83 and north of I-94). More information can be found on the back side of this newsletter.

58-04-01. Annual township meeting -

When held Notice. The electors of each township annually shall assemble and hold a township meeting on the third Tuesday in March at such place in the township or in an adjacent township as the board of township supervisors thereof shall designate. Notice of the time and place of holding the meeting must be given by the township clerk at least ten days prior to the meeting by publication in a legal newspaper published in the township or, if there is no such newspaper, then in the county's official newspaper. Before a change in the place of holding the annual township meeting is made, notice of the contemplated change may be given by any member of the board of township supervisors to the township clerk, who shall have such change published if time allows. Otherwise, the township clerk shall post notice of the change. Where an incorporated city is wholly or partially within the boundaries of the township or an adjacent township, all township meetings may be held in such place within such incorporated city, as the board of township supervisors thereof may designate.

Hay Creek Township currently plans to hold this meeting, beginning at 6:00 PM at Holy Cross Lutheran Church, 7111 Williamson Drive (Hwy 83 and Hwy 1804) on March 20, 2018 beginning at 6pm.

Hwy 83 Alternative Study Area

The Bismarck-Mandan Planning Organization is completing the US Highway 83 Alternative Study in cooperation with the City of Bismarck, Burleigh County and the NDDOT.

According to the handout provided at the first public open house on February 20th, the study area boundaries are: (description of area is as if you are standing in the middle of the study area looking out to the boundaries) - US Highway 83 to the west, I-94 to the south, ND Highway 36 to the north and ND Highway 14 to the east. The area being studied includes the portion of Hay Creek Township that is to the east of Hwy 83 and north of I-94.

The purpose of the study is to:

- Identify, evaluate and develop viable highway alternatives along US Highway 83 north of Bismarck to best serve existing and future stakeholders within the region,
- Analyze potential new routes for regional traffic and identify operational improvements for the State Street corridor,
- Analyze anticipated outcomes of the US Highway 83 realignment on Bismarck and Burleigh County.
